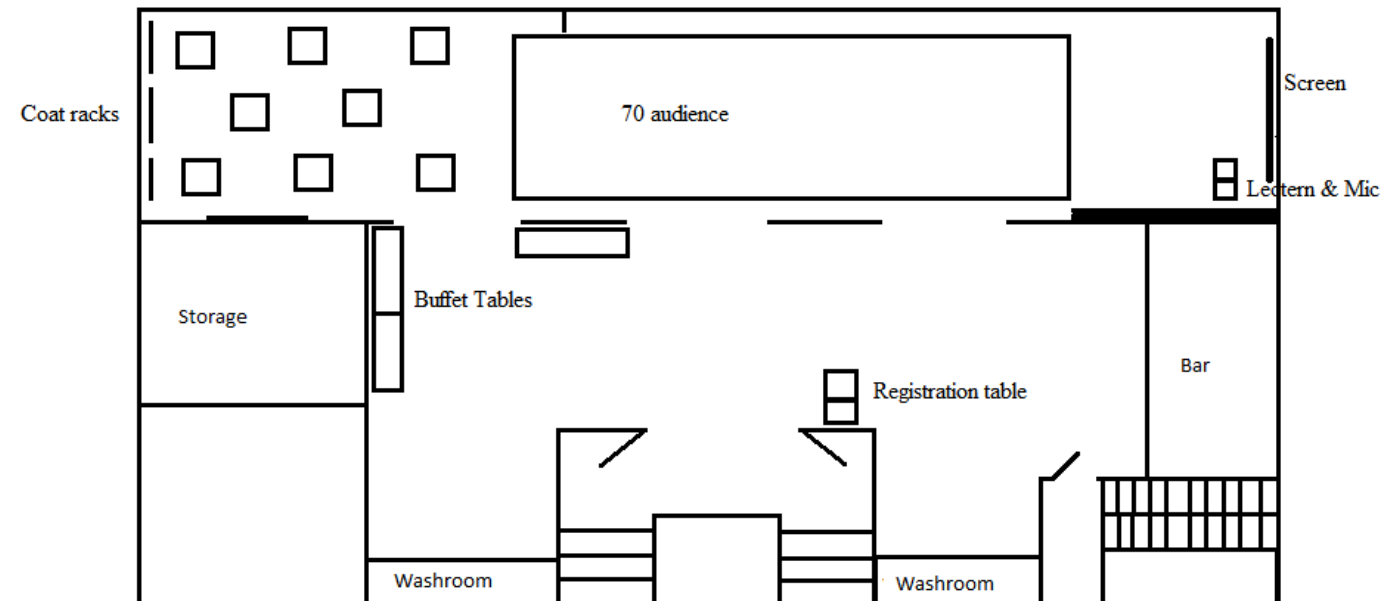
Logistics 1

- We have scheduled long lunch breaks for extensive discussions.



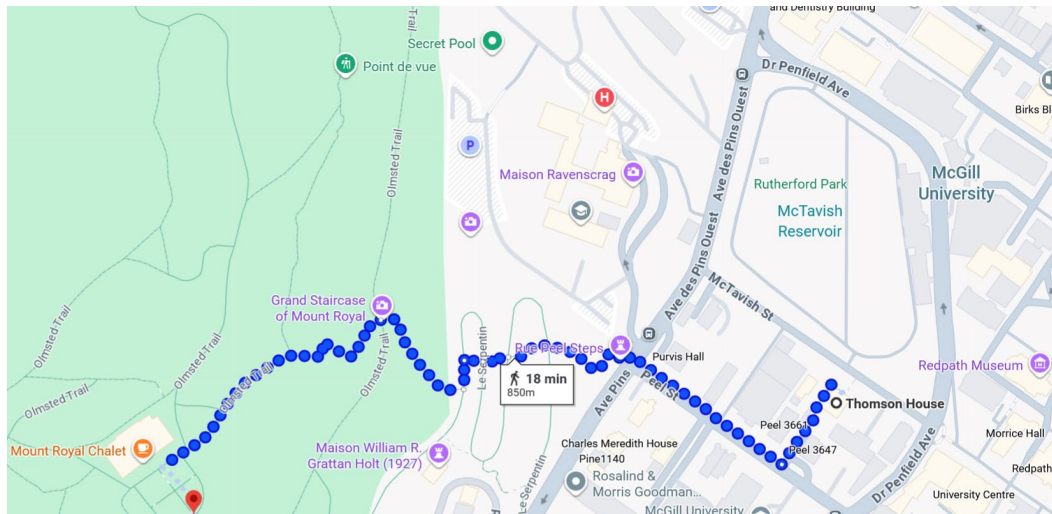

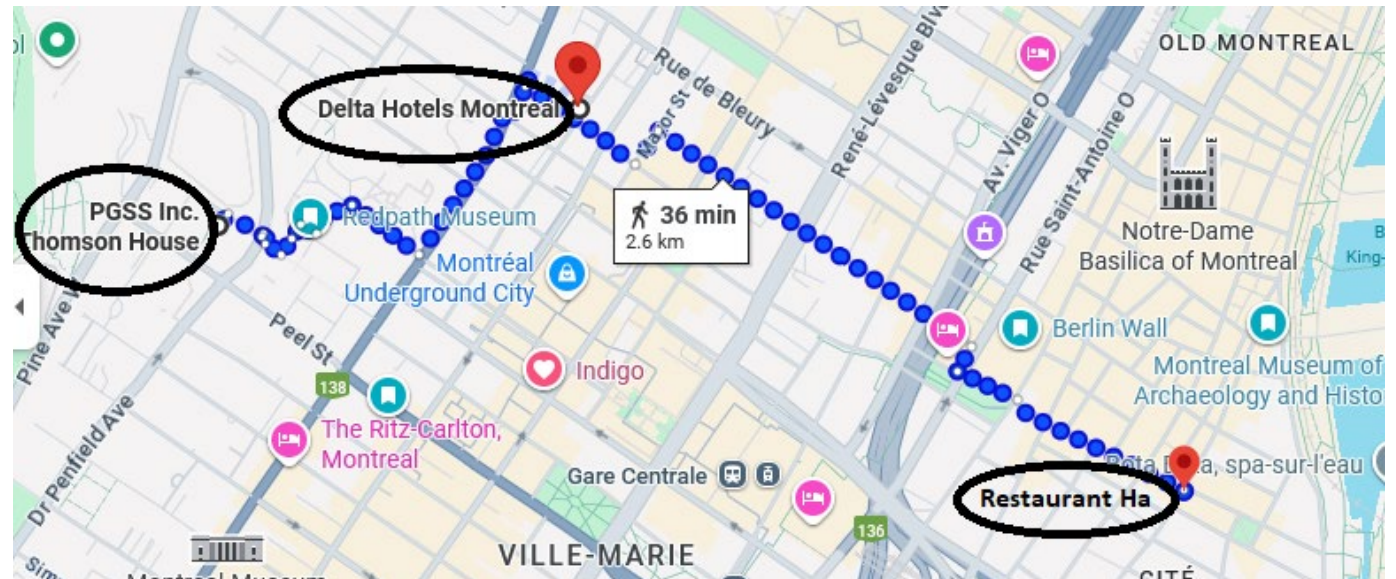
Logistics 2

- We will start with welcome drinks at 7 pm.



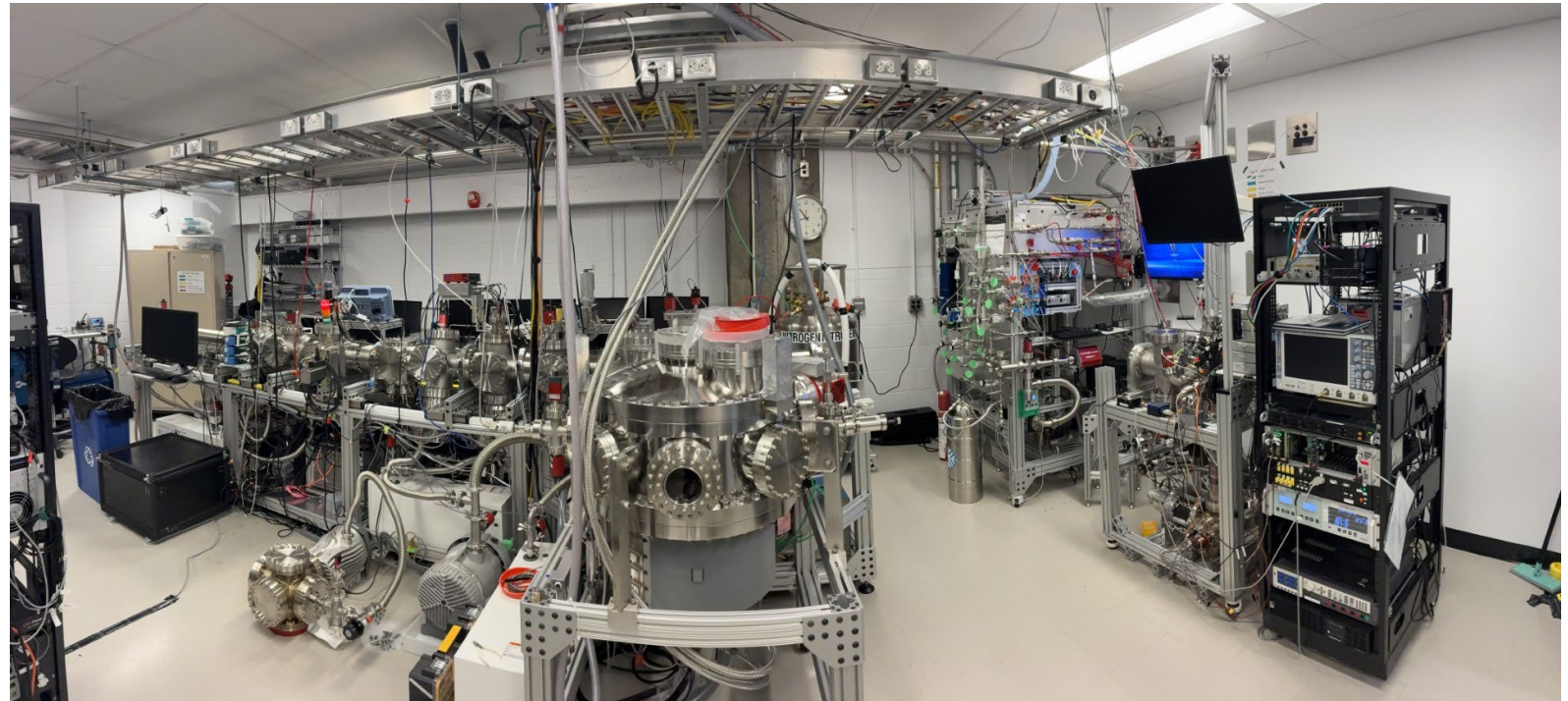
Reception on Thursday

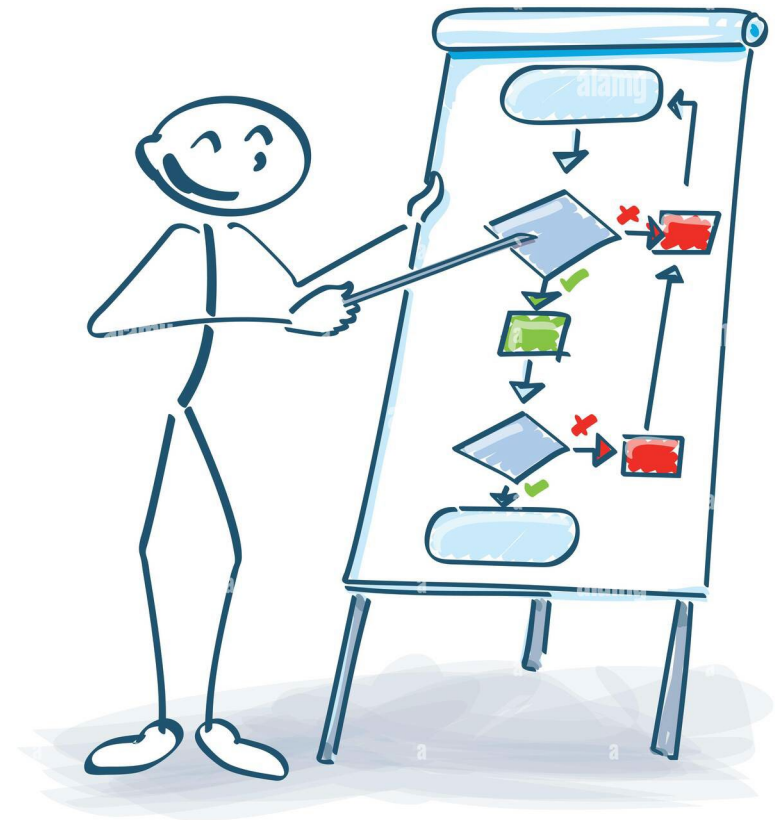
Lab tours
